Participate!

The European Enterprise Awards accept entries in six different categories covering the above mentioned criteria. If you want to participate, send your entry form to your national point of contact. In each country, two applicants will be selected and forwarded to the European Enterprise Awards jury.

Participating in the national and European selection process will give you national and European visibility and publicity. All nominees will be showcased on the European Enterprise Award website and be invited to participate in the award ceremony. Moreover, they will obtain free publicity and coverage in local, national and European media.



How to apply

To be successful, candidates will have to show how their actions have helped to facilitate business and boosted their region's economy during the last two years. The jury will judge on originality and feasibility, impact on the local economy, improvement of local stakeholder relations and transferability of the initiatives.

Are you eligible?

If you are a public authority from the European Union or Norway and you have worked to boost, promote or facilitate the economy, then submit your application!

Eligible are towns, cities, regional and national administrations as well as public-private partnerships between public authorities and entrepreneurs, educational programmes, and business organisations.
